## What is the purpose of the Resource Guide?

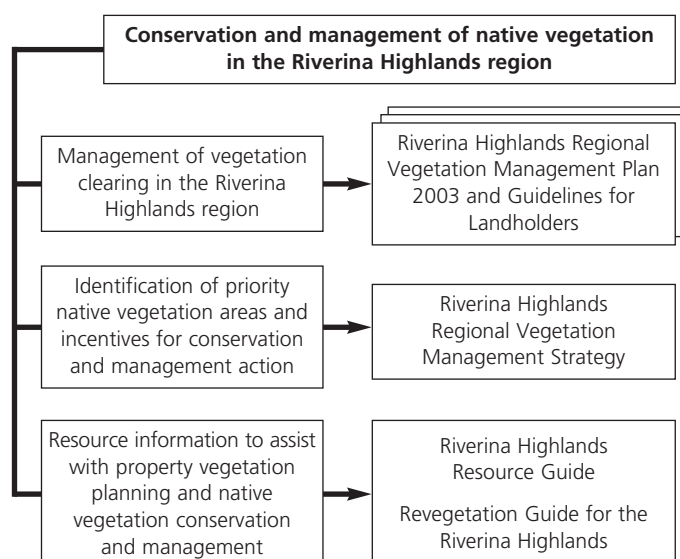
This Resource Guide has been developed to support the *Regional Vegetation Management Plan 2003* and the *Regional Vegetation Management Strategy* developed by the Riverina Highlands Regional Vegetation Committee for the Riverina Highlands region.

The Resource Guide has been developed to provide resource information to land managers to guide the development of property vegetation plans. It provides a 'toolkit' for the conservation and management of native vegetation at a property scale within the region.

## Where does the Resource Guide fit?




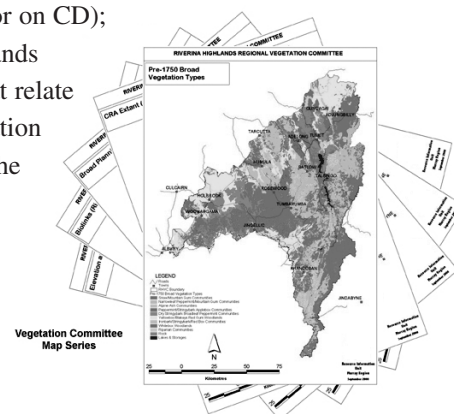
### Other available resource information
