Guidelines for landholders and land managers

Guidelines have been developed to further explain elements of the Riverina Highlands Regional Vegetation Management Plan (RHRVMP) exemptions and Regional Vegetation Management Strategy (RVMS) for the Riverina Highlands region. These guidelines are similar but more detailed and locally specific than state-wide Department of Sustainable Natural Resources guidelines and standard consent conditions.

How were the guidelines developed?

The guidelines that are regionally specific have been drafted or are to be drafted by the Riverina Highlands Regional Vegetation Committee and associated Working Groups to ensure they reflect regional conditions. Those that apply at a State-wide level are to be reviewed and updated to ensure regional relevance.

Which guidelines are specific to the Riverina Highlands and which apply at a State-wide level?

The guidelines relevant to the Riverina Highlands region and further explain the provisions of the Riverina Highlands RVMP and RVMS include:
