The data ranges from observed values where a high accuracy would be anticipated through to modelled results and estimates where accuracy can be highly variable depending on a range of factors.

To address the inconsistencies in accuracy and prevent misuse of the data in the accounts, all figures in the water accounting statements are accompanied by an assessment of accuracy as defined in the table below.

Water account data accuracy estimates key	
A = +/- 10%	
B = +/- 25%	
C= +/- 50%	
D = +/- 100%	

In addition to an accuracy code each figure in the accounts is cross-referenced where appropriate to a numerically linked note where detailed information can be found relating to that figure.
